4.3. Population, Gender and development

More than any other thing currently in eastern part of our country there is a widespread internal displacement, political unrest and socio-economic crisis. Assessing these issue from different angels is timely and a professional responsibility of HU, CSSH. Additionally, the indigenous and governmental peace and conflict resolution institutions are not properly functioning and downgraded to the level of nonexistence. Moreover, there is a widespread urban sprawl and traffic accident in the region too. Thus, the following research issues could be considered as top priority areas for research projects in 2018/19.

- Internal Displacement (ID): Cause, consequence and implications in Eastern Ethiopia;
- Population increase, Urban Sprawl, rural –urban interface, traffic accidents and its consequences and implications in Eastern Ethiopia;
- Indigenous Institutions and the role of females, the role of gender based socio economic and political institutions, assessing/exploring the dynamics strategies & challenges of gender parity; the rise of female labor migration, gender based violence
- Unemployment, prostitution, homelessness, crime, poverty, risk behavior of the youth
- Political unrest, inter-regional and cross border conflicts and illegal business

- **4.4. Governance and the rule of Law:** In the last few years and even currently, there is discrepancy between theories and praxis of constitutional ideals, the implementation of of international conventions and human rights declarations. Accordingly, it would be good if attention is given for the following research issues:
 - 4.1 Democracy, human rights, rule of law,
 - 4.2 Ethnic federalism and alternative perspectives,
 - Ethnic and cultural rights,
 - Land rights, land laws
 - Study and revival of indigenous customary institutions, indigenous Conflict resolution mechanisms and peace building processes,
 - Democracy in third world and challenges of democratic reforms,
 - Transitional justice,
 - Media law (print and electronic) journalism, role of Media and communication in advancing peace, justice.
